## **RESOLUTION 2017A-1**

A RESOLUTION OF THE SNOHOMISH COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT NO. 12 BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SUPPORTING CITY OF MARYSVILLE PROPOSITION NO. 1 REGARDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROPERTY TAX LEVY.

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2017 the Marysville City Council adopted Resolution 2413 entitled: "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY AT THE AUGUST 2017 PRIMARY ELECTION, A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING THE RESTORATION OF THE REGULAR PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE TO BE MADE IN 2017 FOR COLLECTION BEGINNING IN 2018 AND CONTINUING THROUGH 2023; THIS PROPOSITION WOULD AUTHORIZE THE CITY TO SET AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIFTY CENTS (\$.50) PER THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) OF ASSESSED VALUATION FOR 2018, AND AUTHORIZING INCREASES IN THE LEVY OTHERWISE ALLOWED BY RCW 84.55.050 BUT NOT MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED TEN PERCENT (110%) FOR EACH OF THE FIVE SUCCEEDING YEARS, THE PROCEEDS FROM SUCH LEVY TO BE USED FOR THE PROVISIONS OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE AND SERVICES; SETTING FORTH THE BALLOT PROPOSITION; DIRECTING PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO TAKE NECESSARY ACTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER PROPERLY RELATED MATTERS"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to law, public notice of the intent to consider adoption of this Resolution has been given and an opportunity for the public to provide opposing views has been provided; and

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the Board of Commissioners for Snohomish County Fire District No. 12 that it is essential and necessary for the protection of the health and life of the residents of the Snohomish County Fire District No. 12 that emergency medical services be provided within the District. Such services will necessitate the expenditure of revenues for the maintenance, operations, equipment and personnel in excess of those which can be provided by a regular tax levy; and

**WHEREAS,** it is in the public interest for the Snohomish County Fire District No. 12, to provide basic and advanced life support services, and emergency medical transportation services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 84.52.069, a regular property tax levy may be assessed for the purpose of funding emergency medical care and services;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners for Snohomish County Fire District No. 12 supports to passage of City of Marysville Proposition No. 1, a Property Levy for Emergency Medical Services to be placed before the voters in the

City of Marysville on the August 1, 2017 ballot. The proposition which the Board Commissioners for Snohomish County Fire District No. 12 supports reads as follows:

## CITY OF MARYSVILLE, WASHINGTON

## PROPOSITION NO. 1

Emergency Medical Services Property Tax Levy

For the purpose of continuing to deliver emergency medical services, will the City of Marysville be authorized to impose a permanent regular property tax levy of fifty cents (\$0.50) per one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) of assessed valuation commencing in 2017 to be collected from 2018 to 2023 and to limit increases in the levy to one hundred ten percent (110%) in each of the years from 2019 to 2023, as provided in City of Marysville Resolution No. 2413?
