Resolution 2009B-2

A Resolution Opposing Marysville School District's Consideration of Closing Marysville-Pilchuck High School Swimming Pool

Whereas the Marysville School Board has stated it is considering closing the public pool located at Marysville-Pilchuck High School, and
Whereas the Marysville Fire District provides life safety services to roughly the same population served by the Marysville School District, and
Whereas there are countless feet of lakefront, riverfront, and waterfront within the shared jurisdiction, and
Whereas it is impossible to determine the number of lives saved through decades of public swimming instruction provided at the Marysville-Pilchuck pool, and
Whereas effort toward the prevention of tragedies such as drowning will save our community from untold suffering and loss, and
Whereas the pool at Marysville-Pilchuck is the only publicly owned access point for swimming instruction within the entire jurisdiction, and
Whereas the prevention of accidents through education and instruction meets the highest purposes of both the Marysville School District and the Marysville Fire District,

Be it therefore RESOLVED by the Marysville Fire District Board of Directors that the ongoing operation of the public pool at Marysville-Pilchuck is a matter of public safety and an essential component of the community's educational curriculum , and

Be it further resolved that the Marysville Fire District Board of Directors is opposed to any reduction of public swimming pool services within our community.
