One Injured in Travel Trailer Fire

Marysville, WA – Marysville Fire District responded early this morning to a fire involving a recreational vehicle in the 16000 block of West Lake Goodwin Road.

Neighbors reported hearing an explosion and observed flames coming from a travel trailer at approximately 4:20am on Friday, March 20th. Crews from Station 65 arrived first on scene and quickly located a single occupant, a woman in her 60s. She was transported to Providence Regional Medical Center for treatment. Her condition is currently unknown.

Firefighters worked successfully to contain the fire and prevent it from spreading to nearby structures. The cause of the blaze remains under investigation by the Snohomish County Fire Marshal's Office. Cost of damages is yet to be determined.

Recreational vehicles should undergo regular safety checks to make sure that all systems are working correctly. Smoke and carbon monoxide alarms should be tested monthly to ensure early warning in an emergency. Plan at least two ways out and keep exits clear at all times, since fires can spread quickly in small spaces. Keep a fire extinguisher easily accessible- quick action can make all the difference.
