SUMMARY: <p>The parking areas and curbs at Station 61 are failing and in need of repaving. Budget for this project are to be allocated from the Public Safety Building remodel and improvements capital reserve fund. This project has significantly exceeded the original estimates and to complete the other remodel projects at this location an adjustment to the allocated budget may be required.</p> <p>The Marysville Fire District solicited bids in accordance with Washington State bid requirements and in accordance with District policy for the repaving of the parking areas and curbs.</p> <p>Two bids were received as a result of the bid process and both were deemed as responsive. Associated Paving, LLC responded with the lowest responsive bid. Replacement of the system is expected to be completed prior to Sept. 30, 2026.</p> <p>Should the District decide to move forward with the paving project and as the lowest responsive bidder, staff recommends award of the bid to Associated Paving, LLC.</p>	

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Motion to award the Station 61 paving bid to Associated Paving LLC. and authorize District staff to enter into a contract to perform proposed work.
